## IN THE MATTER OF: O ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER PARENT EDUCATION PROGRAM FEE D O COURT CLER ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2003-38

The superior court of each county in Arizona is required by statute to provide an education program for parents involved in divorce cases with child custody issues. The court is authorized by law to charge a fee for this program to all non-indigent parties in these custody proceedings. This past year the state legislature raised the permissible limit of the fee to \$50.

A review of the Mohave County expenditures for costs of providing the parent education program shows that the revenues generated by the present fee will no longer cover the expenses.

Therefore, to ensure that a quality parent education program is provided in these critical cases in the superior court,

IT IS ORDERED increasing the fee for attending the Parent Education classes from \$30 to \$50 for all parties ordered or otherwise required to complete the program, or any who voluntarily enroll, on or after January 2, 2004.
